Dongyuan Zhao

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Dongyuan Zhao was born in Northeast China and received his B.S. in 1984, M.S. in 1987 and Ph.D. in 1990 from Jilin University, China. After obtaining his Ph.D., he obtained a faculty position at the Department of Fine Chemical Engineering, Shenyang Institute of Chemical Technology, China as a Lecturer and was promoted to Associate Professor in 1992. From 1992-1998, he held overseas positions as a visiting scholar and postdoctoral fellow at the University of Regina, Canada; Weizmann Institute of Science, Israel and University of California, Santa Barbara, USA. In 1998, he joined the Chemistry Department of Fudan University, China as a Professor and is now the Director of the Advanced Materials Laboratory. Currently, he is also a Fragment Professor at the Department of Chemical Engineering, Monash University, Australia. He was selected Chinese Academician of Science in 2007, Council Member of the International Zeolite Association in 2004, Council Member and General Secretary of International Mesoporous Materials Association (IMMA) in 2002. He has received many international awards that include the Third World Academy of Sciences (TWAS) Prize in Chemistry (2008), IMMA Award (2008) and DuPont Professor Award (2005). He is now the Associate Editor of the *Journal of Materials Chemistry*, and Co-Editor of the *Journal of Colloid and Interface Science*. He is also a member of the editorial board of many international journals, such as *Chemistry of Materials*, *Chemistry – An Asian Journal*, *Nano Today*, *Nano Research*, *Dalton Transactions* and *Nano*. He has authored over 400 peer-reviewed papers and published 39 patents. His papers have also been cited over 20,000 times (h index of 65).
