## Hsian-Rong Tseng

*Associate Professor, Department of Molecular and Medical Pharmacology, University of California, Los Angeles, USA*



Hsian-Rong Tseng is Associate Professor at the Department of Molecular and Medical Pharmacology of the University of California, Los Angeles (UCLA), USA. He also holds membership in the Crump Institute for Molecular Imaging, Institute for Molecular Medicine and California NanoSystems Institute at UCLA. Tseng received his B.S in Chemistry from Tunghai University (1993) and his Ph.D. in Organic Chemistry from National Taiwan University (1998) in Taiwan. He conducted his postdoctoral study with Professor Sir J. Fraser Stoddart at UCLA, working on the development of molecular electronic devices, before he joined the faculty of UCLA in 2003. Tseng's current research focuses on the development of microfluidic systems as enabling technologies for the fields of chemistry, *in vitro* molecular diagnostics and *in vivo* imaging.
